Low Carbon Buildings Programme - Phase 2

Phase 2 grants are open to public sector not-for-profit organisations. Check the [Scheme Conditions](#) to confirm your eligibility.

Organisations can apply for between 30% and 50% of the cost of installing approved [microgeneration technologies](#), (depending on technology), supplied and installed by Framework Suppliers.

Organisations can receive up to £1.0 million in grant funds over the lifetime of the programme. This may be for several different sites, although a separate application will be required for each site. A site may consist of more than one installation. A maximum of three eligible technologies can be applied for at each proposed installation.

Applicants who intend to use non-Framework Suppliers and/or install technologies not eligible under Phase 2, should refer to [Phase 1](#) to determine their appropriate grant stream.
